Rank in Class: All subjects and all grades except for "P". Rank is **NOT** weighted and covers six semesters for class of 2016; seventh semester rank not available until approximately mid-February.

SCHOOL/COMMUNITY

Klahowya Secondary School (KSS) is the third and newest high school in the Central Kitsap School District (CKSD), opening in September of 1997. The Class of 1999 was the first graduating class. KSS is the only secondary school in the district with enrollment of grades 7-12; the other high schools, Olympic and Central Kitsap are grades 9-12. CKSD serves a rapidly growing and unincorporated area of Kitsap County centered around Silverdale which is the main shopping and commercial area in the county. The U.S. Navy has a significant presence with three large installations in the immediate area. These facilities have a large civilian work force in addition to the military. KSS serves a predominantly middle class community but the full socio-economic range is represented. Approximately 20.4% of KSS students receive free or reduced lunch.

WHERE IS KSS? We are located across the Puget Sound from Seattle between state route 3 and the Hood Canal. Driving Direction: take the Newberry Hill exit off of SR 3 (the southern of 2 Silverdale exits) and go west up Newberry Hill. KSS is on the left.

UNDERSTANDING KSS TRANSCRIPT

CERTIFICATE OF ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT

Shows "CAA" if student passes a Math and Biology EOC exam and the Reading and Writing HSPE. Required to graduate.

HIGH SCHOOL & BEYOND

Shows "HIGH SCHL & BEYOND" and is a course on students' future plans. Required to graduate.

HONORS COURSES

Shows "HON" before course title.

JUMP START

Courses (taken before grade 9) show a "JS" or "RS" before the course and are included in the 9th grade credits.

RUNNING START

Courses show "CC" before the course code.

SPECIAL EDUCATION

Courses are designated with either a "PV" or "SE" before course code and a "PV" or "LNC" before course title. We do a great deal of inclusion.

WEST SOUND TECHNICAL SKILL CENTER

Courses show an AM or PM before course code and are usually 1.5 credits per semester.

CURRICULUM

SPECIAL FEATURES

JUMP START—State mandated - allows students in grades below 9 to receive high school credit if they take a high school level course with high school (grade 9 or above) students.

RUNNING START—State mandated - allows qualified juniors and seniors to take some or all of their courses at a community college (courses numbered 100 or higher) on a tuition free basis. In Washington, students enrolled in public institutions (high schools, community and four year colleges) are guaranteed that they can use these courses/credits toward both high school graduation and a college associate or bachelors degree.

WEST SOUND TECHNICAL SKILL CENTER—Juniors and Seniors may attend KSS for three periods and the Skill Center for three periods taking vocational courses offered in 14 different programs (e.g. construction trades, cosmetology, protective services and welding trade).

GRADES 6-12—Emphasis is now on a seamless education and this model contributes to that. Many 7th and 8th graders have the opportunity to take high school course work, especially in foreign language, math, and electives.
